Awesome AVID Stats

Recently, REV applied for *The Golden Ribbon Award* and they chose to focus on REV's AVID program! During the application process, we came across some outstanding stats:

*REV AVID students score "proficient" or "advanced" on the CAHSEE at a 16.6% higher rate in math than the rest of the student population and 25% higher rate in English.

*58% of REV AVID seniors are earning a 3.0 academic GPA or above...19% higher than the rest of the student population.

*Last year, 97% of REV AVID seniors completed their A-G requirements vs. 28% of REV's senior class.

*Last year, 100% of our AVID seniors were accepted to a four year university!
