No saving of seats. No smoking, e-cigarettes, tobacco products of any kind, alcohol, food and/or drinks are not allowed inside the bowl with the exception of unopened water bottles. Video cameras and equipment must be lap-held. Everyone, including small children / infants, must have a ticket. **ANYONE WHO CANNOT COMPLY WITH THESE RULES WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE BOWL AREA.**

- ❖ Photo ID required to pick up your diploma – *no exceptions!*
