## Summer Dual Enrollment Course Registration Process

- ★ Attend Dual Enrollment Application Meeting – **Wednesday, April 12<sup>th</sup> 3:00-5:00 PM** at CVHS in the Library
- ★ Submit completed paperwork to the counseling center at CVHS, REVHS, or RHS **no later than April 28<sup>th</sup>**
- ★ Complete online course registration – **Thursday, May 18<sup>th</sup> 3:00-5:00 PM** at CVHS in the Library
- ★ Courses begin at CVHS the week of June 12<sup>th</sup>, and end July 20<sup>th</sup>

**NOTE:** *Summer Dual Enrollment Courses are for incoming RUSD juniors and seniors ONLY – class of 2017 seniors are no longer eligible for this program.*

All courses begin the week of June 12, 2017, at 1:00 PM, following the RUSD normal summer school day.

Student Success and the College Experience	CHC 100	Introduction to the college experience, including academic and career self-assessment and strategies for success. Exploration and application of theories of physical, social and psychological development toward the goal of success in college. Survey of the tools necessary to excel academically, socially, physically and emotionally including goal setting, decision making, and life planning; time management; critical thinking; lifelong learning; financial planning; and wellness.	3 Lecture	M T W Th 1:00 - 3:30 PM
Fire Protection Organization	FIRET 100	Provides an introduction to fire protection; career opportunities in fire protection and related fields; philosophy and history of fire protection; fire loss analysis; organization and function of public and private fire protection services; fire departments as part of local government; laws and regulations affecting the fire service; fire service nomenclature; specific fire protection functions; basic fire chemistry and physics; introduction to fire protection systems; and introduction to fire strategy and tactics. This course is one of three courses required before entrance into the Fire Academy.	3 Lecture	M T W Th 1:00 - 3:30 PM
Beginning Acting	THART 120	Introductory instruction in acting techniques. Exercises in improvisation, theatre games, and exercises to develop flexibility, imagination, agility, expressiveness and awareness of body movement. Exploration of basic textual analysis of plays, characterization and scene work	3 Lecture	M T W Th 1:00 - 3:30 PM
